ABET: To Instigate, help, encourage

Sec. 107-120

Principle: The person abetted /Actually commits the crime

Abettor: The person who abets the crime

Abetment of a thing:

- 1) By Instigating a person to commit crime
- 2) By engaging in a conspiracy
- 3) By intentionally aiding a person to commit it

Abetment By Instigation

Counseling, suggesting, encouraging, procuring, commanding another to do an act
