I. Kuchipudi

II. Lambadi :

Dancers dress themselves in brass anklets, bangles and jewellery and depicts day to day task of farmers.

II. Kolattam/ Kolanalu

Stick dance and usually performed during village festivals



III. Dhimsa Dance :

Mainly performed by women of Porja Tribe. Dedicated to the welfare of the domestic life.



IV. Burrakatha :

Consists of 1 main performer and 2 co-performers. It is a narrative entertainment.



V. Veeranatyam:

Dance of the brave. Performed by to appease Lord Shiva.
