Kaviraj Shyamal Das

- He was born in Dokaliya village in Bheelwara in 1838
- He was court poet of Maharana Shambhoo Singh of Mewar
- His famous work - **Veer Vinod(it is available in 5 volume)**
- Veer Vinod gives the description about the history of Mewar; it was started during the tenure of Mewar ruler Shambhu Singh in 1871 and completed at the time of Mewar ruler Fateh Singh.

- He was also appointed as Chairman of Mewar Library
- Maharana Sajjan Singh of Mewar gave him the title of Kaviraja
- He was also selected for Historical society of London Fellow and also became member of Royal Asiatic Society of Bengal .

- In 1881 he was sent to sign an agreement with Bheels ,(he successfully signed the agreement at Rishabhdev)
- The Maharaja of Mewar gave him the title of Kaviraja.
- British government gave him the title of Kesar -e - Hind and Mahamahopadhyay

Gorishankar Hirachand Ojha

- Born in Rohida Village of Sirohi in 1863
- He was curator of Rajasthan Museum at Ajmer(He was also an archeologist.)
- He wrote the history of Sirohi state in 1911
- He further wrote history of Guhil-Sisodiya of Mewar and history of Dungarpur, Banswara , Pratapgarh etc.

- He tried to write the history of Jodhpur and Bikaner state which remained incomplete
- He also translated Nensi Ri Khyat and Annals of Colonel Todd in Hindi
- In 1914 he was given the title of Rai Bahadur

- In 1933 he was given the title of Bhartiya Anushilan by Hindi literature conference.
- His important works -Prachin Lipimala(it was written in Hindi and for this his name was registred in Guinness world book) ,Biography of Colonel James Todd ,History of Rajputana
