History of Marwar

Rao Satal ji Rathore

(1489-1492)

- Son of Rao Jodha
- He sacrificed his own life to keep the honor of his people
- When Afghan soldiers abducted 140 girls from Merta, he set out with an army to rescue the girls. In the **battle of Peepar**, Satal killed the Afghan commander, Gudhla Khan, and saved the girls, but he succumbed to his wounds and died.

- After his death his brother Rao Suja ji Rathore became ruler of Jodhpur(1492-1515 AD)
- Rao Suja played important role in freedom of Mewar, during his tenure Rao Bika attacked on Jodhpur.

Rao Ganga Ji Rathore (1515-1532 AD)

- Grandson of Rao Suja
- Rao Ganga constructed the Gangelao Talab in 1518 AD and Ganga ki Bawari
- During the battle of Khanwa he sent 4000 Rathore Cavaliers under his son Maldeo Rathore
- He also brought idol of Shyam Ji from Sirohi and built Gangshyam temple at Jodhpur.

- It is believed that he fell from Balcony of his fort under the influence of Opium (but Dr. Ojha said he was killed by his ambitious son Maldev who pushed him from the Window, Mundiyyar Ri Khyat too confirms this fact.)
